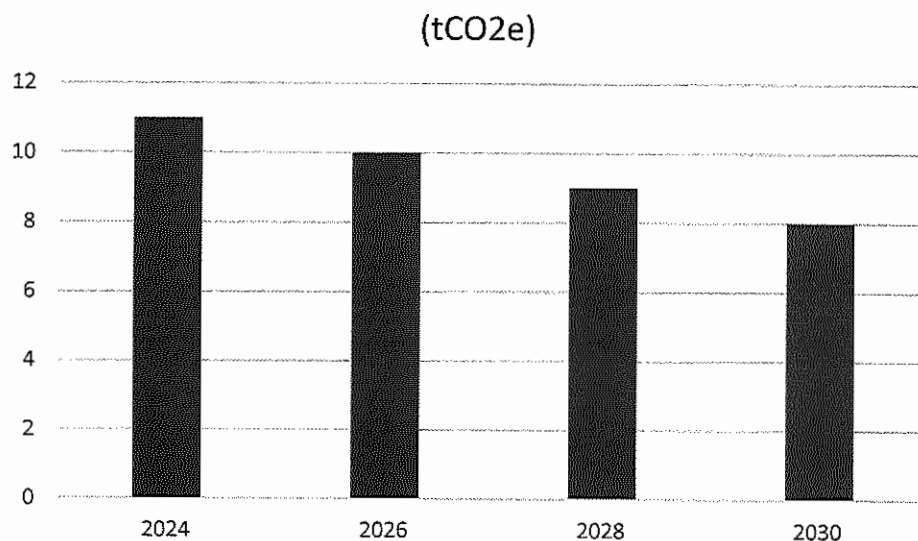

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

PVA Hygiene has been dedicated to improving its carbon footprint and is ISO 14001 certified and working with Emitwise to monitor its Carbon output.

This year PVA Hygiene has offset 44 tonnes of carbon over 40 years by planting 12 trees in the U.K through 'Make it Wild'

PVA Hygiene has engaged in a rewilding project in the business park and created a pond to encourage wild life.
